Things to know:

Childcare

Kindergarten is free of charge in Rhineland-Palatinate. Pre-kindergarten (0-3 years) and after-school care centers (6+) cost monthly fees depending on the parents' income. School is generally free of charge in Germany.

Health-insurance

All foreigners living and working in Germany can access subsidized state healthcare, but it is mandatory for all residents to have some form of health insurance. Contributions depend on your wage and are split evenly between employees and their employers.
